Rieter Skill Development Academy

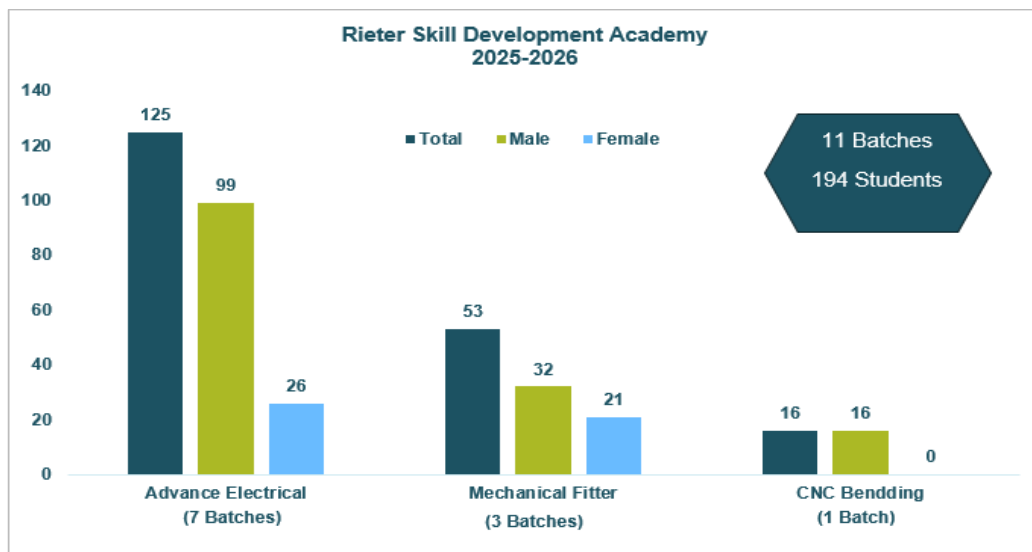
The Rieter Skill Development Academy (RSDA) is a flagship Corporate Social Responsibility initiative of Rieter India Pvt. Ltd., established near the Wing Plant in collaboration with the non-profit organization Uday Gujar Foundation to enhance employability among youth from nearby villages.

Built on a deep understanding of industry skill requirements, RSDA follows a highly practical, hands-on training methodology, combining structured theoretical inputs with extensive on-the-job exposure. RSDA offered courses through the technical training partners Skillsomics, including Advanced Electrical/Mechanical Fitter/CNC Bending/CNC Grinding.

Students are trained directly on machines and engaged in electrical wiring and welding practices, ensuring they develop industry-relevant, job-ready technical competencies rather than just academic knowledge. RSDA also aims at providing equal opportunities to female students in the nearby villages. As a result, around 15 to 20% of students are females who are qualified for technical jobs post completion of their courses at RSDA.

Since its inception in March 2023, RSDA has trained and placed over 500 students, consistently enabling their transition into technical roles across nearby industries. In Financial Year 2025 to 2026 alone, 194 students were trained and most of them were successfully placed in different companies.
